The homes are specifically designed for those who might otherwise live in residential care but wish to live independently, as well as those who risk feeling isolated if living in standard housing with care and support. The houses help promote independence and choice while providing the benefit of caregivers and support to meet complex needs and the opportunity for mutual support and participation in the life of the community. One of our major goals is to build more homes like these throughout Georgia.

- Assist in providing and/or locating medical and adaptive equipment
- Scholarship programs
- Assist with living arrangements
